

JOB DESCRIPTION LESSON VOLUNTEER

POSITION TITLE: Lesson Volunteer

REPORTS TO: Instructor or designee

Qualifications

1. Minimum age of 13.

- 2. Physically capable of performing assigned tasks; lifting saddles, arm extensions, standing, walking (for 45 min. at a time, on uneven surfaces.)
- 3. Sidewalkers must be able to execute an emergency dismount of rider
- 4. Willing to learn and follow the policies of Partners Therapeutic Horsemanship.
- 5. Able to accept constructive feedback.
- 6. Able to commit to a consistent volunteer schedule.
- 7. Be flexible, adaptable and enthusiastic with a positive attitude
- 8. Dress in an appropriate, safe and professional manner. (Able to follow dress code)
- 9. Horse knowledge and experience helpful but not necessary.
- 10. Able to work unsupervised around ranch

Responsibilities:

- 1. Lesson volunteers work under the direct supervision of a Partners Therapeutic Horsemanship Instructor.
- 2. Notify an instructor in advance if you will not be able to participate as scheduled.
- 3. Lessons are planned based on the numbers and abilities of volunteers assigned.
- 4. Arrive 30 min prior to lesson.
- 5. Sign in each time you volunteer
- 6. Check Lesson Board for student, horse and tack assignments
- 7. Assist instructors by leading horses or side walking with riders.
- 8. Other tasks may also include assist with lesson set up, unmounted activities, tack cleaning, grooming, moving horses, site clean-up, make feed buckets, feed horses, clean horses' waters or stalls.
- 9. Follow safety rules and regulations.
- 10. Communicate feedback, concerns or any grievances to the Instructor or Director.
